Lesson 4: Types of sentences

A quick session today! Did you know that there are 4 different 'kinds' of sentence? A sentence is either:

A statement – A basic sentence that tells you something, e.g. Norwich is a great city.

These end with a full stop.

A question – A sentence that asks you something, e.g. Have you ever been to Norwich?

These end with a question mark.

An exclamation – A sentence that gets across strong emotions or excitement, e.g. What a great place Norwich is!

They always end with an exclamation mark.

A command – Sentences that tell you or someone to do something, e.g. Go and visit Norwich.
