This week, we are continuing to focus on Multiplication and Division. <https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/>

Before you start division, make sure you have practised:

Using arrays to multiply by 10

Using arrays to multiply by 5

Using arrays to multiply by 2

Can you also practise using multiplication to solve worded problems? You can find these on the website too!

Key vocabulary: multiplication, times, lots of, groups of, altogether, array, equal.

When beginning to use division, remember that to divide just means to share!
 $6 \div 2$ means 6 shared between 2.

Practise dividing by using circles. If I was working out $6 \div 2$ I would draw 2 circles and count putting dots into each circle, alternating as I go and counting to 6. I should end up with 3 dots in each circle. I now know that $6 \div 2 = 3$. Have a go at dividing by 10, 5 and 2!

Key vocabulary: division, divide, share, array, equal, equally, alternate.
