



Dear Parent / Carer

I am writing to inform you that the setting will be taking part in a jointly run operation between Norfolk County Council, Norfolk Police and our provider, it is called Early Years Operation Encompass. Early Years Operation Encompass has been set-up to help Early Years Providers to provide support to children who have been present at incidents of domestic abuse & violence. We know that children can be significantly physically or emotionally harmed when they are involved in, present or witness to domestic violence.

The setting will receive a confidential notification from Norfolk Children's Services before 9am or as soon as possible thereafter on the morning after any domestic incident which Norfolk Police have recorded where a child at their provider has been involved in, present or witness to domestic violence.

The provider has designated Mr. Gilroy Singh and Miss. Lacey as Key Adults. Our Key Adults have received training from Operation Encompass and Norfolk County Council to allow them to use the information that has been shared to make sure that the right support is available for children and their families who have been involved in or witnessed a domestic violence incident.

We are keen to offer the best support possible to our children and we believe this is going to be extremely beneficial for all those involved.
